The 2023-34 school year is quickly coming to a close. Each year, it seems as if the fourth quarter moves more quickly and becomes busier than the year before. I hope you will take a few minutes to read through the many announcements below. We have much to celebrate at NDA in the talents and dedication of so many students and faculty.

As you are aware, our goal at Notre Dame Academy is to protect the health and wellbeing of our students, faculty, and staff while continuing to meet our responsibility to educate our students. With that objective in mind, last year we partnered with Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center (CCHMC) to ensure that NDA has a cardiac emergency response plan in place to establish specific steps to take action in a cardiac emergency at our school. We then conducted a very successful cardiac emergency drill in April, which led us to become the first school in Kentucky to be designated as a Heart Safe school in collaboration with Cincinnati Children's Heart Institute and Project ADAM.


To maintain our Heart Safe School designation and comply with Kentucky school law, we are required to run a drill and review our process every year. In an effort to ensure everyone is prepared for a Cardiac Emergency on campus or out in the world, as well as for our cardiac drill scheduled later this month, we will review the CERP (Cardiac Emergency Response Plan) with our students this Friday, April 19. 

The Sound of Music is a beloved show around the world. Based on the true story of the Von Trapp Family Singers, this musical captures a personal tale of growth and hope amidst the horrors of World War II. The Sound of Music tells the tale of young postulant Maria Rainer, whose free spirit has trouble fitting into the rules and regulations of Nonnberg Abbey. Commissioned by the Mother Abbess to serve as the governess for seven motherless children, Maria transforms the Von Trapp family home from a place of dour rules and regulations to one filled with joy, with laughter, and with music. But as the forces of Nazism take hold of Austria, Maria and the entire von Trapp family must make a moral decision.

JOIN TLC IN SUPPORTING GO!PANTRY




JOIN THE PLANNING COMMITTEE - BE A PART OF THE FUN!
