

FROM THE SCHOOL NURSES COVID-19 CASES RETURN

Dear Parents,

As you can see in the report above, after several weeks of reporting no COVID-19 cases at NDA, we have 4 new reported cases this week. This is reflective of the uptick in cases in our community and around the country. While the positivity rate in Kentucky is up to 4.35% this week, the <u>NKY Health Department COVID-19 Data Dashboard</u> is still showing our COVID-19 community level as low which suggests that people stay up-to-date with COVID-19 vaccines and get tested if they have symptoms.

We are doing our best to keep our community safe and heathy the remainder of this school year. Please be vigilant if your daughter is experiencing symptoms and let us know if someone in your household is being tested for COVID-19 or your daughter is exposed to or tests positive for COVID-19.

MCORE Foundation will be back at Notre Dame Academy on Saturday, May 21, 2022, to provide our preventative heart screening program. We have worked with MCORE to provide a screening program to our community since 2019. This is an amazing opportunity for a student to have their heart evaluated for any abnormalities in a cost-effective and convenient manner, especially if they have had Covid-19.
