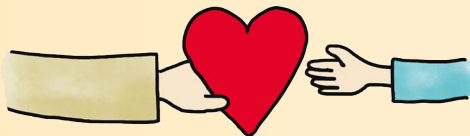

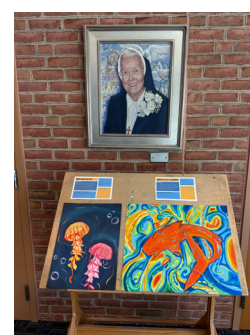

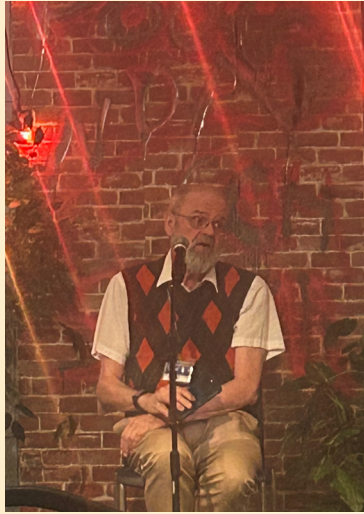

## 2026-2027 CALCULATOR REQUIREMENTS FOR NDA

Dear Incoming Freshman:

As the 2025-2026 school year nears the end, the math department at Notre Dame Academy would like to communicate that all students will be expected to have a NumWorks calculator for their math classes in the 2026-2027 academic year.

For those who may be unfamiliar with NumWorks, it is a more modern and intuitive graphing calculator developed in collaboration with teachers and designed with today's students in mind. Inspired by the electronic devices that students use daily, this calculator's app-based design empowers them to explore and discover mathematics on their own. NDA's math department believes that equipping our students with this device allows us to make math education accessible and approachable for all students.

The NumWorks graphing calculator is included on the list of permitted calculators for all College Board tests (PSAT, SAT, and AP) and it also meets the requirements for the ACT calculator policy. You can read more about exam compliance at <https://www.numworks.com/calculator/exams/>.

The NumWorks graphing calculator (replacing the previously used TI-84) costs \$124.99. The NDA math department was able to generate a discount code for any NDA students interested in purchasing this calculator at a discounted rate. More information about the NumWorks graphing calculator can be found at <https://www.numworks.com/>. We encourage you to explore this option in preparation for the upcoming academic year. There is a NumWorks app that can be downloaded for free onto a device for additional exploration and operates exactly like the device itself.

Below is a discount link that allows you to purchase a NumWorks graphing calculator for \$92.99 instead of the typical retail price of \$124.99. **Please note that this link will expire on July 31.**

**All calculators purchased through this discount link will be shipped directly to school where students will receive their new calculators in their math classes.**

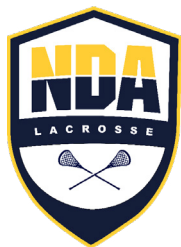

## GIVE YOUR STUDENT A STRONG START ATTENTION CLASS OF 2027 PARENTS

**Want your student to get a jump start on the college application process? Does your student need help with crafting an outstanding college essay?** If so, then your student should attend the CCH College Application Camp this summer! Senior Counselor, Mrs. Jessica Brown, will be hosting a 4-day workshop (8/3-8/6) for seniors to get started on the college application process. This 2.5 hour/day camp session will allow students to have time to work on the application, craft an essay, and create an activity list that highlights their attributes. On the final day of the camp, students will get the opportunity to meet with college reps and get feedback from the experts on their essay and/or application. The reps will also be here to share updates about their schools, and they will also hold a Q&A panel for parents whose student is participating in the camp. So, parents, this is a great time to get all your questions answered on how you can best support your student in the application process. **Additionally, NDA will host Application Workshops before school starts and when school is back in session.** Attending one of these sessions is mandatory and students will learn more about timelines, deadlines, transcripts, letters of recommendation, SCOIR, and actually START a college application during the workshop. It's a really valuable time for students to gain information and ask all the good questions they might have. See the dates below to plan accordingly. Sign ups will be sent out in July.
