June 18

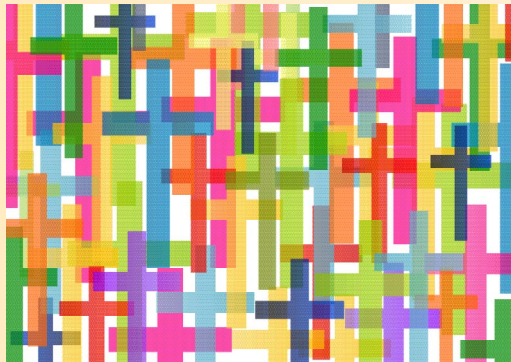

CELEBRATING THE CLASS OF 2026

The final days of the school year were filled with meaningful traditions, celebrations and milestones as Notre Dame Academy honored the Class of 2026 and celebrated their journey from students to alumnae.

The celebrations began with the annual Baccalaureate Mass, where seniors gathered with family, friends, faculty and staff for one final celebration of faith and sisterhood before graduation. During the ceremony, Salutatorian Linda France delivered a heartfelt reflection encouraging her classmates to embrace lives rooted in faith, love and purpose.

The celebration continued with the annual Senior Breakfast and Awards Ceremony, which recognized the many accomplishments of the graduating class. The morning opened with a beautiful prayer led by School Co-Presidents Teagan Kruer and Lila Harris. Seniors were honored for academic achievement, leadership, service and involvement throughout their four years at NDA. Members of the Class of 2026 earned more than \$12.2 million in scholarships and completed more than 16,000 hours of service during their time at Notre Dame Academy.

During the breakfast, Hope Dierker was named the recipient of the prestigious Sisters of Notre Dame Distinguished Graduate Award. The award recognizes a senior who exemplifies the mission and heritage of the Sisters of Notre Dame through academic excellence, faith, service, leadership and commitment to Gospel values. As part of the honor, the recipient's name is recorded in a special book kept at the Sisters of Notre Dame Motherhouse in Rome, Italy.

The week culminated with Notre Dame Academy's 118th Commencement Ceremony as graduates officially became the newest alumnae of NDA. Senior Class Presidents Phoebe Desch and Ella Nienaber opened the ceremony by reflecting on the memories, friendships and sisterhood shared by the Class of 2026. Valedictorian Jacie Hail then delivered an inspiring address encouraging her classmates to focus not only on accomplishments, but on the relationships, faith and moments that truly shape a meaningful life.

Throughout the week's celebrations, the Class of 2026 reflected the mission of Notre Dame Academy and the enduring spirit of the Sisters of Notre Dame. As these graduates begin new journeys in college, careers and service, they leave NDA prepared to continue making a difference in the world.

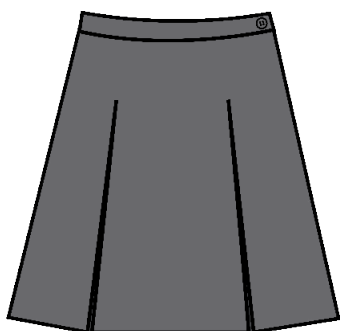

2026-2027 CALCULATOR REQUIREMENTS FOR NDA

Dear Incoming Freshman:

As the 2025-2026 school year nears the end, the math department at Notre Dame Academy would like to communicate that all students will be expected to have a NumWorks calculator for their math classes in the 2026-2027 academic year.

For those who may be unfamiliar with NumWorks, it is a more modern and intuitive graphing calculator developed in collaboration with teachers and designed with today's students in mind. Inspired by the electronic devices that students use daily, this calculator's app-based design empowers them to explore and discover mathematics on their own. NDA's math department believes that equipping our students with this device allows us to make math education accessible and approachable for all students.

The NumWorks graphing calculator is included on the list of permitted calculators for all College Board tests (PSAT, SAT, and AP) and it also meets the requirements for the ACT calculator policy. You can read more about exam compliance at <https://www.numworks.com/calculator/exams/>.

The NumWorks graphing calculator (replacing the previously used TI-84) costs \$124.99. The NDA math department was able to generate a discount code for any NDA students interested in purchasing this calculator at a discounted rate. More information about the NumWorks graphing calculator can be found at <https://www.numworks.com/>. We encourage you to explore this option in preparation for the upcoming academic year. There is a NumWorks app that can be downloaded for free onto a device for additional exploration and operates exactly like the device itself.

Below is a discount link that allows you to purchase a NumWorks graphing calculator for \$92.99 instead of the typical retail price of \$124.99. **Please note that this link will expire on July 31.**

All calculators purchased through this discount link will be shipped directly to school where students will receive their new calculators in their math classes.
