I would also like to congratulate Kira Kent on receiving the 2023 NDA Distinguished Graduate Award from the Sisters of Notre Dame. This is a well deserved honor as Kira is certainly an outstanding witness to a Notre Dame Academy education.

As we begin our summer break, we give thanks for the many ways in which God's Goodness and Provident Care have blessed our school this year. While we are all looking forward to the summer break, as a community of lifelong learners rooted in the charism of the Sisters of Notre Dame, we are also excited about the start of our next school year. 

FINALFORMS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FINALFORMS ACCOUNTS

Get ready for next year by updating or creating your FinalForms accounts. Notre Dame Academy partners with FinalForms, an online forms and data management service which allows you to complete and sign forms for your daughter(s) online. FinalForms saves data from year-to-year, meaning you will never need to enter the same information twice! You may review your data at any time throughout the year to verify that it is current. **All parents and students are expected to use FinalForms and complete their updates for next year by June 1, 2023 (if participating in athletics) or by the first day of school.** If participating in athletics, this will include needing a valid, signed KHSAA physical uploaded in Final Forms before participating in any athletic activities.

If you do not have a FinalForms account, please create one account at: https://notredameacademy-ky.finalforms.com and follow the prompts to create the parent account, begin your daughter's account and sign your forms. Your daughter's NDA gmail should be used when setting up her account. Once the parent/guardian creates the account, the student will be prompted in her NDA email to submit her forms. Please note: if you have already turned in your daughter's immunization record, you do not need to upload separately. School personnel will upload for you.

If you already have an account for a returning student:

Login to your account and click MY STUDENTS to get started. Make sure you are updating information for the 23-24 school year.

DRESS FOR SUCCESS UNIFORMS FOR THE 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR

Approved Uniform pieces are listed below as stated in our Student/Parent Handbook:

Notre Dame Academy has a school uniform that consists of:

- a gray uniform skirt or uniform slacks (the skirt or pants must fit properly, be zipped and buttoned, hemmed appropriately and free of stains, rips, and/or holes). Students are required to obtain a new skirt or pants if it no longer zips, has tears, holes, or stains. **Please note: Skirt should extend below student's fingertips when arms are fully extended at one's side.**
- a white or light blue banded Notre Dame Academy polo shirt
- solid white, gray, black or navy blue socks
- appropriate shoes that have a back to them
- nametag/lanyard

Optional items that may be purchased and worn with the uniform include:

- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy pullover sweater
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy cardigan sweater
- a navy blue Notre Dame sweater vest new item!
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy sweatshirt (available for purchase through Schoolbelles and NDA's Bamboo tique)
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy fleece
- a navy blue blazer with NDA's emblem for special occasions such as Mass, award ceremonies, etc.
- gray, black, or navy blue leggings
- black dress slacks for designated events



CLEANING DAY THANK YOU!



2023-2024 COMMON READER BOOK

Notre Dame Academy has selected next year's Common Reader book which is *Between Shades of Gray* by Ruta Sepetys. *Between Shades of Gray* tells a story from 1941 where fifteen-year-old Lina Vilkas is arrested by the Soviet secret police and deported to Siberia with her mother and younger brother. The author's website says Lina is a young woman who fights for her life, vowing that if she survives she will honor her family, and the thousands like hers, by burying her complete story in a jar on Lithuanian soil. Lina's writings and drawings chronicle her fight for survival, her difficulty accepting help from a Soviet guard she's supposed to hate, and her struggle to retain faith in mankind amidst the terror. We look forward to bringing this story to all students, faculty and staff at Notre Dame Academy and celebrating the book's theme when we return next fall.

Tennis won the Region and represented well down at State with Hailey Fullenkamp and Taylor Meenach playing in the doubles quarter finals today at 3:30 p.m.


