




## SUPPORTING OUR PANDAS DAY OF HOPE

### SUPER DAY TESTING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20

On Wednesday, September 20, we will be having testing for juniors, sophomores and freshmen. Seniors will be having a college work day with Admission Counselors and NDA Teachers available for application and essay help. All students need to report this day at 8:00 a.m. even though it is a Wednesday. We will dismiss after testing has finished close to 11:30 a.m. The freshmen and sophomores will take the College Equipped Readiness Test (CERT) as a practice for the ACT on their iPads. The juniors will take a written ACT practice test that is scored by Torchprep (ACT test prep company).

### ATTENTION FRESHMEN AND SOPHOMORES OPT OUT FOR TERRACE METRICS

Attention Freshmen and Sophomore parents. Your student will be taking the Terrace Metrics on Monday September 18. This is an assessment that measures social and emotional learning and assesses risk. We assess only the resiliency scales and you as a parent will receive your daughter's individual results in the week following the administration of the assessment. ### JOIN TODAY! DRUG FREE CLUB

Parents & Guardians:

What is keeping you from signing up your daughter for Drug Free Club at NDA?

## **Q:** Why should we reward our daughter for something we expect of her anyway?

**A:** Drug Free Club is a form of Positive peer pressure! It helps students resist temptations to make poor choices. Their brains are not fully developed yet, which can make them weak during impulsive moments. This could be the difference between them saying Yes and NO in an unexpected difficult moment.

### How to become a Drug Free Club member at NDA:

- 1. Apply and pay: Submit your one-page paper application and payment to the office or do so online <u>HERE</u>. The fee is \$25/year. If freshmen sign up for 3 years (\$75), their senior year is free.
- 2. Test drug free.
- 3. Receive your ID Card at school.
- 4. Enjoy rewards from school and from our local community!
- 5. Stay drug free! Random drug tests can come at any time.

### Applications will be accepted through October 31.





### YOU'RE INVITED THE KY GOVERNOR'S SCHOLARS PROGRAM (GSP)

GSP is a 5-week summer residential program for outstanding KY students after completing their junior year of high school. Established in 1983, the program provides academic and personal growth through a strong liberal arts program balanced with a full co-curricular and residential life experience while living on a college campus. Students complete an application and compete with others from across the state. The Program's mission is to enhance Kentucky's next generation of civic and economic leaders. Those selected attend the program free of charge. The <u>GSP website</u> has basic information and will be updated in mid-September with information for GSP 2024.
