Tickets are only \$25 per person, so grab yours before they're gone. Secure your spot on the red carpet by Friday, No-



### **RED RIBBON WEEK**


In celebration of Red Ribbon Week, students can wear red shirts and accessories (with uniform bottoms) TOMORROW (10/26).

#### DR. ERICSON'S INNOVATIONS IN EDUCATION:

## TRANSFORMING LEARNING

Dr. Ericson works diligently to find ways to engage, inspire, and enhance the learning of the students in the Academic Enhancement Program classes at Notre Dame Academy. Recently, Dr. Ericson was 1 of the 150 founding members from 38 countries selected as a certified Read Theory educator to help "build the future of ReadTheory, emerge" as leaders in the edtech space, and expand impact for students". Read Theory is a reading program that helps students improve their reading comprehension skills. Dr. Ericson has been implementing Read Theory into her classroom since 2014. Read Theory has helped NDA students improve their reading comprehension skills in their courses. Dr. Ericson also utilizes the data from Read Theory to collaborate with the English Department and Student Services Department to support the students. Dr. Ericson was also selected as a Pear Deck Inspearational Educator. Pear Deck is a learning tool that allows teachers to engage their students as well as formatively assess their students' learning. Dr. Ericson has collaborated with her colleagues on how to implement Pear Deck into the classroom. She has been implementing Pear Deck into her classroom since 2018. These accomplishments required Dr. Ericson to consistently implement both Read Theory and Pear Deck into her classes, to create and publish Pear Deck lessons for national and international use, and to attend professional development workshops for both programs.





- Only Parents/Guardians receive test results. (NEVER the school!)
- · Members can rely on testing as an "out" for drug related situations by saying, "I can't, I might get tested".
- · Parents are notified via email about perfect moments and ways to talk about drugs.
- Members receive a full color photo ID card to show to local merchants to receive community rewards for their drug free lifestyle.
- · Retesting of random members continues throughout the school year.
- Membership at NDA has steadily increased over the years. Last year 83% of Pandas joined; CURRENT MEMBER-SHIP IS 73%.




#### YOU'RE INVITED
