

The games are in Winchester, KY (about an hour and a half away), and NDA is sending a fan bus to cheer on the Pandas.

To support our volleyball Pandas, school will dismiss by noon on Friday if the team wins tomorrow night. If you are interested in traveling on the fan bus on Friday, please complete the permission slip that was emailed and submit to the office with the required \$20. The \$20 will pay for transportation and one ticket cost. Students will need to bring money for dinner and for the championship game ticket – approximately \$10. QUESTION, PERSUADE, REFER SUICIDE PREVENTION TRAINING FOR PARENTS AT NDA

With suicide being the second-leading cause of death among people ages 15-24, the National Alliance on Mental Illness calls for a increase in suicide prevention initiatives and conversations surrounding mental health and depression with our youth. Larry McNabb is a local Vocational Rehabilitation Certified Counselor and a Master Trainer with the QPR Institute and will be presenting a Suicide Prevention Training for parents at Notre Dame Academy on **November 14 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.** QPR stands for Question, Persuade, Refer and the training will help you recognize the warning signs of suicide, know how to offer hope, and know how to get help to save someone's life. Please make plans to attend if you can. NDA's faculty and staff completed QPR training in August during our annual back to school meetings and students will be trained by grade levels through the next several weeks. This is an important step in our ongoing efforts to eliminate suicide rates in our young adult populations.



What is Showcase? It's a student directed and choreographed variety show with this year's theme of "Not Your Average Battle of the Bands." This is a no-cut show, and everyone who auditions gets in. There are opportunities for singing, dancing, acting, and a combination of all!

How to audition?

- <u>Sign up</u> for a time slot for singing, acting, and/or dance call.
- <u>Fill out the audition form</u> here with your schedule conflicts and interests
- If you're interested in a dance solo or feature, sign up for the dance call on Thursday.
- If you're interested in an acting feature, audition with a memorized 60sec monologue from play, tv show, or movie.
- If you're interested in a singing feature or solo, audition with 16bars (or 60sec) of any song that showcases your voice (could be from a musical or a regular song). Make sure to have a karaoke track to sing along with.
- Want to audition for an ensemble role (no solos, no featured dance, or no featured acting parts)? You can either prepare something from above OR you can show up and do a cold reading (a provided monologue that you don't have to memorize) and sing a traditional song (happy birthday, national anthem, amazing grace, etc.)
- What if I want a dance feature and cannot come to the dance call on Thursday? Email Miss Smith about a digital audience for dance.
