

# LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL <

Dear Parents,

I hope your Advent has been filled with peace, hope, joy and many special blessings of this holy season. Our students, faculty and staff gathered along with the Diocese on Monday for the celebration of the Mass. It was a very nice way for everyone to come together as a community of believers to prepare ourselves for the coming of Christ this Christmas.

While this will be the last Panda Press Weekly newsletter in 2020, it will not be our last communication to you before Christmas. Following new guidelines from the Governor earlier this week and the updated Diocesan Return to School Requirements, we are working on our plan for how we intend to proceed on January 4 following Christmas break. We are consulting with the Diocese and will communicate which plan we will be following from our Pandas Return to Campus Plan once a decision has been reached.

Please know that our goal is to protect the health and wellbeing of our students, faculty and staff while continuing to meet our responsibility to educate our students. Our first choice will always be to follow Plan 1 of our Pandas Return to Campus Plan with students receiving in-person instruction with safety precautions in place. We are very fortunate at Notre Dame Academy to have three viable options and the technology in place to keep our students engaged in gainful learning through each of our three plans. With the continued rise in COVID-19 positivity rates, there are many variables to consider including the comfort level of our student and faculty in regard to in person learning as well as the reliability of the self-reporting within our community. Please be assured that the spiritual, academic, emotional and physical wellbeing of your daughter is at the heart of every decision we make at NDA.

We thank you for your continued support and ask that you keep NDA updated on any COVID-19 related issues involving your family. It will be much easier to facilitate a safe and timely return to in person classes if we have the data we need to fully assess our situation in regard to cases of COVID-19 within our NDA community. - Please keep NDA updated on any COVID-19 related issues involving your family. As of today, Wednesday, December 16, we have had one reported case of a student testing positive for COVID-19 within the last week. As per our requirements, she is in quarantine. We have consulted with the Diocese of Covington about these recent cases. Since we transitioned to Plan 3 of our Pandas Return to School Plan with Remote Learning @ NDA, contact tracing within our NDA community is not necessary. 
## **GRIEF SUPPORT**


